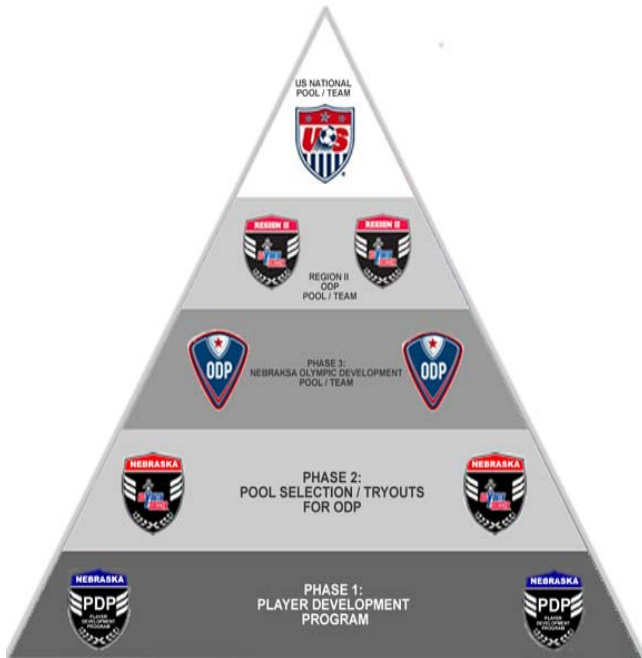


## NEBRASKA ODP

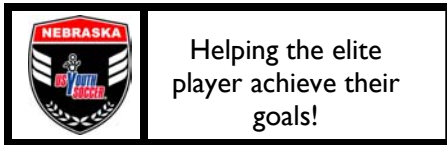

### US YOUTH SOCCER OLYMPIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM PHILOSOPHY

To identify players of the highest caliber on a continuing and consistent basis, which will lead to increase success for the U.S. National Teams in the international arena.

### OBJECTIVES

The Nebraska State Soccer Association Olympic Development Program seeks to establish a process, approved by Nebraska State Soccer and not in conflict with Region II, the US Youth Soccer Association, or United States Soccer Federation, for identifying and training the outstanding male and female youth soccer players in the State and to provide each such player the best opportunity to qualify for Nebraska State-Soccer, US Youth Soccer Region II, and US Soccer National Team programs. The program also provides exposure to assist in obtaining college scholarships and provides the best opportunities for each player to further develop his or her soccer skills so as to reach the highest possible level of soccer.

US Youth Soccer ODP is based upon birth year instead of the August 1 to July 31 soccer calendar.

### PHASE 1: PLAYER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

**Ten PDP Sites:** 1. Omaha 2. Lincoln 3. Kearney 4. North Platte 5. Blair 6. S. Sioux City 7. Columbus 8. Norfolk 9. Grand Island 10. Scottsbluff

**Ages:** 1997, 1996, 1995, 1994 Boys and Girls  
Consists of three total sessions to introduce the player to top level ODP coaches and training.

### PHASE 2: POOL SELECTION / TRYOUTS

**1 Site:** Tranquility Park, Omaha  
**Ages:** 1997, 1996, 1995, 1994, 1993, 1992

Consists of three tryout/evaluation sessions to determine a maximum of 30 players to a state pool for training and competition.

### PHASE 3: OLYMPIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

**Ages:** 1997, 1996, 1995, 1994, 1993, 1992

The selected state pool will be involved in various events. Events will consist of Competitions against other ODP state teams, tournaments, and training. In preparations for camp, teams will train with special guest coaches from top Universities and Nationally Licensed coaches in Nebraska & surrounding states. There is also a Mini State ODP Residential Camp in July that will help prepare travel squads for the rigors of Region II camp in Illinois in early to mid July.
